Welcome to BEAR CREEK GOLF COURSE. I am an eight year old facility laid out in the rolling country side of Carroll County. I am located about 3.25 miles outside of the city of Westminster on route 97. I am proud to welcome MISGA to enjoy my unique layout.

You will find playing Bear Creek to be a novel change from your everyday golf course. I am not long. I can be tested between 5800 yards and 6329 yards. It takes a couple of trips around me to gather my secrets and recognize my weaknesses. You can be rewarded with a little local knowledge or local advice.



It is not often you will find a golf course that is proud to have a par 3 as its #1 handicap hole. But wait till you have the chance to challenge my #14! 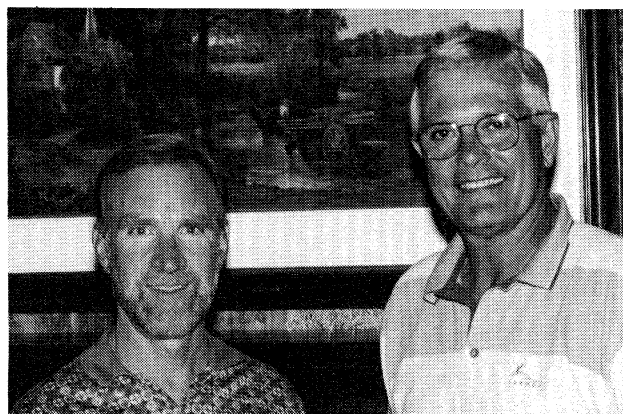
